About the *Open up* project

Sadly this is our last newsletter. the Erasmus+ Open up project will end on 31/03/2023. The project partners are putting effort into finalizing the four following tools that aim at **developing the capacity of professionals** working **in mainstream schools** and **youth organisations** to ensure quality inclusive education for young people with sensory disorders :


- An accesibility guide including practical information to better host young people with sensory disorders in your premises and engage them in educational activities
- A 3-days face-to-face training programme_to become a 'resouce(s) person' who has gained practical knowledge and interpersonal skills that can be applied and shared in any educational work environment
- An e-learning platform about inclusive education and sensory disorders
- A joint statement aiming at formulating recommandations for policy makers in the field of education to improve the quality of inclusive education in Europe

This toolbox will be free access and available in 5 languages (EN, FR, ES, HR and GR) on <u>the Open</u> <u>up website</u> in early 2023.

Focus on the e-learning platform

The **Open up e-learning platform** is currently tested for final corrections by our muldisciplinary board members (incl. experts about inclusive education and sensory disorders) in our 5 testbeds. It consists of the online version of the 6 training modules developed within our 3-days training programme.

User-friendly, it includes a responsive layout optimized for smartphone and tablet users.



Focus on the Joint Statement

Our **Joint Statement for a 'responsible' inclusive education** was co-written by the Open up partners.

It is the outcome of two and a half years of mutual learning about our national contexts and exchange of good practices. It is addressed to policy makers and formulates recommendations for improving the quality of inclusive education.

This political paper consists of 3 recommendations:

- 1. Health and social care establishments and services must remain or be considered as essential
- 2. Accessibility for people with disabilities must be improved
- 3. Awareness-raising and training must be provided

Our final meeting was held in Almeria, 24-25 October 2022

This final meeting was hosted by Asociación de Personas con Discapacidad Verdiblanca. It launched the final stage of the project.

It was an intense visit for the French and Croatian who could participants face-to-face. attend The Cypriot and the other Spanish organisaton took the 'online' option. Day 1 started with an early flight to the hot late Andalusian summer. First. a guided tour at Verdiblanca main office was proposed to more learn about this organisation supporting people with disabilities.



Then, the afternoon focused on finalizing the Guide and the training programme. Day 2 started with a cowriting session of the joint statement before working on the e-learning platform. Finally, we had the chance to taste typical seafood dishes and explore the city. This project was a true intercultural experience!


Final events will be held locally in February 2023
